

**NOTICE OF DECISION ON REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF WHETHER
A CERTIFICATE OF NEED IS REQUIRED
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**

In accordance with 7 AAC 07.031, the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) has determined that a certificate of need is not required for the health care project or activity described below:

Project/Activity: Install a refurbished upright MRI unit

Applicant's Name: Alaska Spine Institute

Project/Activity Service Area: Anchorage Municipality

Estimated Cost of Project/Activity: \$3,233,819

Summary of Decision: The project may proceed without a Certificate of Need. Alaska Spine Institute appears to meet all of the criteria in 7 AAC 07.001(b), and is considered to be an office of private physicians. Therefore, Alaska Spine Institute is excluded as a health care facility under AS 18.07.111 and its proposed project is not subject to Certificate of Need requirements.
