

**NOTICE OF COMMISSIONER'S DECISION
TO DENY A CERTIFICATE OF NEED
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH**

In accordance with 7 AAC 07.070, the Commissioner of the Department of Health has issued a decision on the Certificate of Need application described below.

Applicant's Name: Alaska Regional Hospital

Project/Activity: Establishment of a Hospital Satellite Emergency Department in Anchorage, Alaska

Alaska Regional Hospital proposes to expand its existing emergency department capacity by constructing a Hospital Satellite Emergency Department, in south Anchorage. The new construction will consist of 10,860 square feet, be a free-standing building and encompass twelve (12) emergency treatment rooms, one (1) CT Scanner, one (1) X-ray machine, one (1) Ultrasound machine, five (5) cardiac monitoring machines, one (1) portable X-ray machine, and one (1) portable C-Arm X-ray machine.

Total Cost of the Project: \$17,621,000

Estimated completion date: January 1, 2025

Project/Activity Service Area: Municipality of Anchorage

Summary of Decision: In accordance with AS 18.07 and 7 AAC 07, ARH's request for a Certificate of Need for its Hospital Satellite Emergency Department has been denied.
