

NOTICE OF A COMPLETE APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF NEED
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

The Department of Health has received an application for a Certificate of Need for the health care facility project described below.

Project/Activity: Expansion of Long-Term Care (LTC) Services at Providence Valdez Medical Center.

Providence Valdez Medical Center proposes to expand its existing co-located LTC facility by adding four additional beds, for a total of 14 beds. The proposed project includes an increase to overall square footage of the current LTC wing, by 2,166 sq ft. This additional space will be used for employee offices and a breakroom, a mechanical room, common areas for patients/residents, and will enhance existing spaces such as the dining room, group day room, and storage areas. Additionally, 3,203 sq ft of the existing LTC facility and 717 sq ft of the acute care space will be renovated as part of the conversion of four acute care rooms to LTC rooms.

Project/Activity Service Area: Valdez Region (Chugach and Copper River Census Area)

A CON Program staff analysis of the application and recommendation must be submitted to the Commissioner within 60 days of this notice, unless additional time, not to exceed 30 days, is granted by the Commissioner. A decision by the Commissioner must be made within 45 days of receipt of the staff recommendation unless additional time is required for the Commissioner to render a decision.
