

**NOTICE OF DECISION ON REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF WHETHER A
CERTIFICATE OF NEED IS REQUIRED
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH**

In accordance with 7 AAC 07.031, the Department of Health (Department) has determined that a Certificate of Need (CON) is not required for the health care project or activity described below:

Project/Activity: North Star Behavioral Health seeks to relocate and reassign existing licensed RPTC and acute care beds and programs among existing facilities.

Applicant's Name: North Star Behavioral Health

Project/Activity Service Area: Municipality of Anchorage

Estimated Cost of Project/Activity: Not to exceed \$1.5 million

Summary of Decision:

A CON is not required for the proposed project because it neither involves new construction, increased bed capacity, nor capital expenditures exceeding \$1,500,000. Additionally, the project will not increase or alter the scope of services currently provided.
